CASUALTY PREPARATION FOR EVACUATION INSTRUCTION

TASK: Prepare a casualty for evacuation

CONDITION: Given a casualty requiring evacuation to a higher level of care for further medical

treatment

STANDARD: Prepare a casualty for evacuation by assessing the casualty's condition, using all

lifesaving measures and recording all findings and treatments

EQUIPMENT: Service-specific first aid kit and any other equipment required per Service guidelines

PERFORMANCE MEASURES: step-by-step instructions

01 Prepare for evacuation by completing steps 2 through 7.

02 Complete the DD Form 1380 TCCC Casualty Card and secure it to the casualty.

03 Secure all loose bandages, equipment, blankets, etc.

04 Secure litter straps as required; consider additional padding for long evacuations.

05 Provide instructions to ambulatory patients as needed.

06 Stage causalities for evacuation and identify litter team(s).

07 Maintain security/safety at the evacuation point.

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
