CASUALTY PREPARATION FOR EVACUATION INSTRUCTION

TASK:	Prepare a casualty for evacuation
CONDITION:	Given a casualty requiring evacuation to a higher level of care for further medical treatment
STANDARD:	Prepare a casualty for evacuation by assessing the casualty's condition, using all lifesaving measures and recording all findings and treatments
EQUIPMENT:	Service-specific first aid kit and any other equipment required per Service guidelines

PERFORMANCE MEASURES: step-by-step instructions

- 01** Prepare for evacuation by completing steps 2 through 7.
- 02** Complete the DD Form 1380 TCCC Casualty Card and secure it to the casualty.
- 03** Secure all loose bandages, equipment, blankets, etc.
- 04** Secure litter straps as required; consider additional padding for long evacuations.
- 05** Provide instructions to ambulatory patients as needed.
- 06** Stage casualties for evacuation and identify litter team(s).
- 07** Maintain security/safety at the evacuation point.
