DHA TCCC Training Requirement

- **Remember: AFMS guidance has been published 19 Aug 21 for DHA TCCC Combat Lifesaver (CLS/Tier 2) Implementation (again, this only pertains to the AFMS)**
 - **All AFMS AFSCs designated to the skill level of CLS/Tier 2 will receive initial TCCC CLS/Tier 2 certification NLT 1 Aug 23' regardless of Regular AF or ARC status**
 - **All AFMS AFSCs designated to the skill level of CLS/Tier 2 will receive certification/re-certification within 12 months before deployment when tasked to deploy**
 - **Regular AFMS personnel (Active Duty) designated to the skill level of CLS/Tier 2 will require sustainment CLS/Tier 2 re-certification every 36 months**
 - **ARC AFMS personnel will receive CLS/Tier 2 re-certification as a “just-in-time” pre-deployment requirement**
